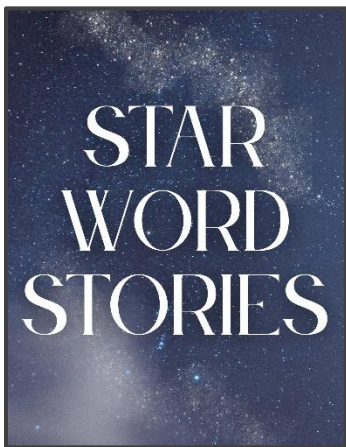

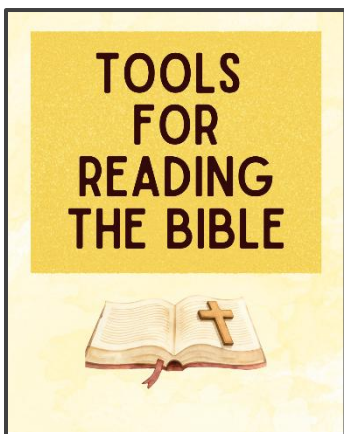


Do you have a Star Word story you'd like to share?

We are looking for folks that are willing to share how their Star Word from 2025 has impacted their year! Stories will be shared on Sunday January 4. If you got a Star Word last year and would be willing to share a story about how your word guided you over this past year, please reach out to Katie or David so we can plan for you to share that story.

The use of Star Words, also called "star gifts," is a prayer practice connected to Epiphany and the new year. The idea is that a list of intention words, or guiding words, are written or printed on paper stars. These paper stars are then distributed to the congregation, who are encouraged to place their star word somewhere they will see it regularly throughout the year to allow consistent reflection on how God has moved through, around, or in

connection to that word. Make sure to come to church on Jan. 4 to get one!



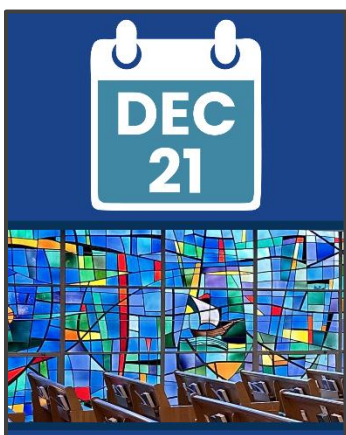
New Class with Jen – Sign up by Dec. 21

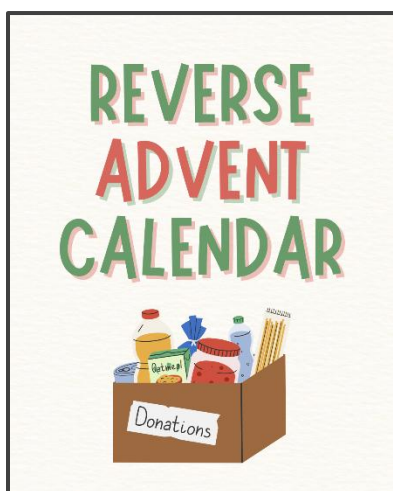
Giving Back

Reverse Advent Calendar

Often an Advent calendar is used to count down days to Christmas by opening a box and discovering a treat or something that helps you focus on the Advent journey. A reverse Advent calendar focuses on giving instead of receiving – a Christ centered idea indeed – since Christmas is all about God's own self-giving as a baby in a manger.

If you follow the items listed on the calendar you will be donating to four of Jackson's First Presbyterian Church's mission projects: Immanuel Lutheran Food Pantry, Jackson Personal Care Ministry, Northeast Elementary, and our diaper ministry. Bring your donations to church **as the month progresses or on Christmas Eve - your choice**. Please let an usher know if you need assistance unloading items from your car. The Peace, Justice, and Mission Committee will sort the items and deliver them to the appropriate organizations shortly after the first of the year.

If you are not up to collecting this many items, **that's okay!** Bring what you can, or make a monetary donation if that works better for you. Simply put "Advent Calendar" on an envelope or in the memo field of a check and make sure it gets to the church office. We will use it to buy coats for the kids at Northeast Elementary.
